

# LIFEGUARD

## GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Responsible for the safety and well-being of persons using the municipal pool.

## SUPERVISION REQUIRED

Works under the direction of the Swim Pool Manager.

## SUPERVISION EXERCISED

Supervision is not a responsibility of persons in this position.

## TYPICAL EXAMPLES OF WORK

- Guards specific section of pool area as assigned.
- May teach swim lessons
- Assists in the maintenance and upkeep of the pool, restrooms and dressing rooms on a daily basis.
- May assist in the tests for chlorine residual and pH content of pool using test kits.

## *DESIRABLE QUALIFICATION FOR EMPLOYMENT*

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY

Some knowledge of swim pool operations preferred but not required. Ability to stay alert for long hours in the observation of person using the swim pool. Ability to withstand exposure to various summer weather conditions (i.e. sun, rain, wind).

Ability to establish and maintain harmonious relationships with pool staff and the general public.

### EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

Certification in Senior Life Saving required. Water Safety Instruction, Red Cross First Aid and CPR are preferred but not a requirement. Advanced First Aid is desirable but not required.

### NECESSARY SPECIAL QUALIFICATION

If under age 18, an Oregon Workers Permit is required.
