

## **CITY OF MILTON-FREEWATER TAXI SERVICE INFORMATION**

The City has enjoyed success with their dial-a-ride taxi ticket service since 1971. Our Taxi Ticket Service is a Senior & Disabled service for seniors age 60 and older, and disabled citizens of any age. Unlimited number of tickets may be purchased at City Hall, 722 S. Main Street in Milton-Freewater between the hours of 7 am and 4 pm, Monday through Friday for the following fee, which fee has remained the same since June 1991:

Citizens residing within the city limits:	\$1/ticket
Citizens residing outside the city limits, but within a five-mile radius of city center:	\$2/ticket

**USE YOUR DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD TO PURCHASE YOUR TICKETS AND HAVE THEM MAILED DIRECTLY TO YOU! OUR FRIENDLY STAFF WILL ASSIST YOU BY CALLING THEM AT 541-938-5531.**

The taxi service is provided Monday through Saturday, 8 am through 7:30 pm. Our taxi drivers are trained to help you in and out of their vehicles, help with any non-motorized mobility apparatus, and will also help with your shopping bags. If you are unable to negotiate the stairs at City Hall, call for a complimentary taxi ride to City Hall and our taxi driver will take care of the necessary business while you wait in the comfort of their vehicle.
